Industry type	Definition and scope
1. Dye and pigment industry	Refers to the organic, inorganic dyes & pigment, coating, paint, and their intermediate synthesis or manufacturing industry.
2. Leather industry (excluding that under Attached Table 1)	Other than that under Attached Table 1, it refers to the leather manufacturing industry using raw, dressed, or salted hides and skins as raw materials in "wet processing" (excluding non-wet process manufacturing).
3. Wool industry	Industry using wool as a raw material and employing washing, degreasing, and carbonization operations.
4. Papermaking industry	Papermaking industry using pulp and waste paper as a raw material or bamboo chips as a raw material, and employing mechanical or semi-chemical pulpmaking.
5. Lime industry	Lime manufacturing industry using limestone as a raw material.
6. Fertilizer industry	Refers to all types of organic and inorganic fertilizer manufacturing industry (excluding only blending enterprises).
7. Acid and alkali industry	Refers to all types of industry manufacturing inorganic acids (such as sulfuric acid, hydrochloric acid, nitric acid, and hydrofluoric acid) or alkalis (such as caustic soda and soda ash).
8. Activated carbon industry	Activated carbon manufacturing industry employing sawdust or coconut husks as a raw material.
9. Asphalt mixing and premixed concrete industry	Mixing industry employing sand & gravel, cement, or asphalt as a raw material.
10. Petrochemical intermediate raw material industry (excluding that under Attached Table 1)	Other than that under Attached Table 1, Industry using petrochemical basic raw materials to produce intermediate raw materials or products.
11. Resin manufacturing industry	Refers to the industry employing polymerization to manufacture resin products (but excluding enterprises using only mixing and processing and not employing polymerization).
12. plastic, rubber	Other than that under Attached Table 1, Refers to the

manufacturing industry (excluding that under Attached Table 1)	industry employing polymerization to manufacture plastic, and rubber products (but excluding enterprises using only mixing and processing and not employing polymerization).
13. Artificial fiber industry (excluding that under Attached Table 1)	Other than that under Attached Table 1, Refers to the industry manufacturing all types of synthetic or regenerated fibers (such as rayon fibers).
14. Textile dyeing & finishing industry (excluding that under Attached Table 1)	Other than that under Attached Table 1, Includes washing and dyeing plants (but excluding textile industry enterprises with no dyeing & finishing operations).
15. Electroplating and anodization industry (excluding that under Attached Table 1)	Other than that under Attached Table 1, Refers to specialist enterprises engaging in electroplating and anodization.
16. Waste processing industry	Manufacturing industry using waste and residue as a raw material manufacturing industry, and including the waste oil and waste solvent refining industry, smelting industry using waste lead, zinc, copper, aluminum, nickel, or their waste residues as raw materials, the waste acid and alkali processing industry, and waste scrap metal incineration and processing industry.
17. Fermentation industry	Refers to the MSG, yeast, amino acid, and citric acid manufacturing industry and brewing.
18. Nickel, cadmium, lead, and mercury battery manufacturing industry	Refers to the industry using nickel, cadmium, lead, and mercury or their oxides as raw materials for batteries.
19. Printed circuit board industry	Refers to enterprises engaged in etching operations.
20. Semiconductor industry	Refers to enterprises engaging in integrated circuit and wafer manufacturing, wafer packaging, epitaxy, mask manufacturing, and lead frame manufacturing.

23. Auto and motorcycle manufacturing industry	Excluding the assembly of bodies and chassis without spraying and painting processes.

Environmental sanitation agent technical grade manufacturing industry	Refers to the environmental sanitation agent technical grade synthesis and manufacturing industry (including the use of microbial preparations for environmental sanitation, excluding processing enterprises employing no synthesis operations).
27. Pharmaceutical technical grade manufacturing industry	Refers to the pharmaceutical technical grade synthesis and manufacturing industry (excluding processing enterprises employing no synthesis operations).
28. Cement clinker
