

## Attached Table 1: Heavy Metal Content Limits and Implementation Schedules for Designated Batteries

| Designated Battery Item   | Heavy Metal Limit                                       | Implementation Schedule |
|---------------------------|---------------------------------------------------------|-------------------------|
| Non-button type batteries | Mercury (Hg) $\leq$ 1 ppm<br>Cadmium (Cd) $\leq$ 20 ppm | Since Jan 1, 2016       |
| Button cell batteries     | Mercury (Hg) $\leq$ 5 ppm<br>Cadmium (Cd) $\leq$ 20 ppm | Since Jan 1, 2017       |
|                           | Mercury (Hg) $\leq$ 1 ppm<br>Cadmium (Cd) $\leq$ 20 ppm | From July 1, 2026       |

Note 1: The Commodity Classification Code (C.C.C. Code) for non-button type batteries are as follows:

- (1) Manganese-zinc batteries with an external volume not exceeding 300 ml:  
C.C.C. Code 8506.10.21.006
- (2) Manganese-zinc batteries with an external volume exceeding 300 ml:  
C.C.C. Code 8506.10.22.005
- (3) Alkaline manganese batteries: C.C.C. Code 8506.10.90.100

Note 2: The Commodity Classification Code (C.C.C. Code) for button cell batteries are as follows:

- (1) Alkaline manganese batteries: C.C.C. Code 8506.10.90.903
- (2) Mercuric oxide batteries: C.C.C. Code 8506.30.00.007
- (3) Silver oxide batteries: C.C.C. Code 8506.40.00.005
- (4) Zinc-air batteries: C.C.C. Code 8506.60.00.000
